NO NEED TO REMOVE

- Paper Clips, Staples
- Spiral Bindings
- Plastic Tabs

CURBSIDE PICKUP

- Regular Trash - Every Monday
- Recycling - Every Thursday
- Holidays - Next Weekday

TRASH CANS

- A Regular Trash Can can be used for Recycling if you Affix a Recycling Sticker
- Stickers are Provided Free of Charge at the Borough Office
