Eligible CDBG Projects

- Morton Borough has no eligible low-to-moderate income areas which qualify for CDBG funding. This means that projects for which the Borough can apply are limited to Planning Activities ONLY. Applications are due by January 6, 2023.
- Planning activities to consider include:
 1. Sanitary Sewer Study
 - Perform cost study to Identify Sources of I/I & Excess Flows
 2. Feasibility/Cost Study for Recommendations from the Morton Connects Study
 - Intersection Improvements/Truck Routes
 - Pedestrian Improvements (ADA transition study)/Bicycle Infrastructure
 - Parking Infrastructure/Gateway
 3. Traffic Calming Study
 - Walnut Street or Yale Avenue
