 - Submitted PECO Green Region Open Space Program \$20,000 with 50% match for Sycamore Woods & Jacobs' Park – Ecological Site Assessment, Tree Risk Assessment, and Management Plan.
 - DCNR Community and Watershed Forestry \$336,600 with 20% match for Community Forestry Resource Enhancements in Sycamore Woods and Jacobs' Park.
 - DCNR Park Rehabilitation and Development \$249,837.50 with 20% match for the Installation of Utilities and Construction of a Splash Pad Water Feature in Jacobs' Park.
